MMS PTSA Monthly Board Meeting minutes for November 7, 2018

Meeting was called to order by Penny Moss at 6:35pm.

Jenny presented the treasurer's report:

Donations are still trickling in, dance made a good amount of money as did box tops. Patient First has pledged to donate another thousand dollars again this year.

Denise Doss presented the principal's report:

Staff is loving the monthly snacks that the PTSA is providing, her message about cell phone use yielded a positive outcome, a bug that allows students to open a second tab while testing on PowerSchool is being addressed.

Penny Moss presented the following committee reports:

Raider Fund - \$9026 in donations and corporate matching thus far. Waiting on another \$800 in corporate matching to come in. A push for more donations is in the works, outcome not determined yet.

Spirit nights - Panera spirit night earned us \$147.67. Next spirit night is at Chipotle on Nuckols Rd. set for 12/4.

Spirit Wear - link to sign up genius is live as of 11/7 to sell stocked inventory. No new orders may be placed. Spring sale to occur for new items.

Box tops - \$300-\$400 was made, depending on whether expired tops go through. Ms. Goss's APL class won and had a donut party provided by the PTSA.

Membership - numbers not available yet. After a glitch with the process, the upload to the state website should take place shortly.

Dance - the dance was well attended with 289 paid students (18 did not show) yielding a gross profit of \$1445.

Penny Moss initiated a discussion as to why the Parent Teacher conferences were not “advertised” in the Sunday message. Many complaints were made by parents. Denise will make sure to correct that for the next time.

Penny Moss discussed the Mathnasium program scheduled for February 26th. It was agreed that a large turnout is expected.

The majority believe a meeting is not necessary for December, therefore, our next meeting will be on January 10, 2019 in the school library.
